CHUBBS CORNER

Custom. Handmade. Chainmaille Jewelry

Rings Sizes: This tutorial is made with; 20awg (0.8mm WD), 4.8mm ID (large), 3.2mm ID (small) rings.
For this weave, you need 2 rings sizes, with the smaller one being able to fit inside the large one.
AR's of 6.0 and 4.0 usually work well, but there is a little wiggle room.

Method 1: Pre-closed Large rings

1. Start with a piece of helm chain, as wide as you need.



2. Add a small ring (green) so that it's sitting in the eye formed by the 2 large rings below it. Add a new large ring (orange).



3. Add another small ring, sitting in the eye again, and connect the last large ring, and add a new one.



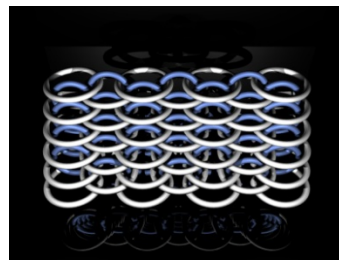
4. Continue across in the same manner until you've added a small ring into each of the large rings from the last line. Spreading the rings like this will aid in the next step.



5. Use the same method to add the next line of rings.



6. Repeat steps 2 through 8 until you've reached your final length.



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Method 2: Pre-closed Small rings

1. Start with a piece of helm chain, as wide as you need.



2. Add a line of small rings (green) behind the small rings from the starting helm.



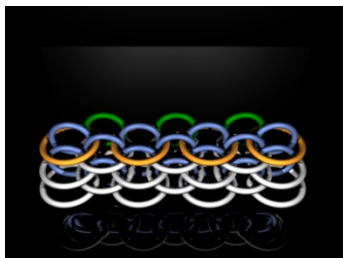
3. Add another row of small rings (green again), behind the rings you just added. Now that you've done this, the rest of the weaving will be really simple.



4. Add a Large Ring (orange) through 2 small rings of the second last row, and add additional small rings (green). Do this for the whole row.



5. Repeat Step 4 for adding rings to the next row. Making sure you're going through the small rings of the second last row available.



6. Continue adding rings in this manner, until you've reached your final length. For your last row, don't add any small rings.
