Ring sizes: This tutorial is made with; 20awg (0.8mm WD), 3.2mm ID rings (AR 4.0).

However any rings with an AR between 3.0 and 5.5 tend to work well for this weave.

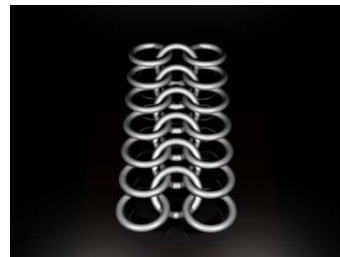
1. Start by creating a 4 in 1 unit, aka a fivelet (open one ring, and pick up 4 rings before closing) and lay the rings like below.



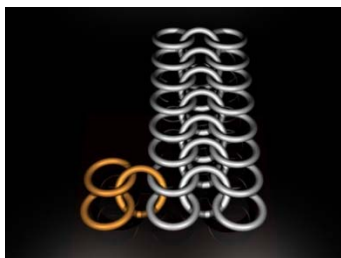
2. Open a new ring, and pick up 2 rings with it. Bring it down through the top right, and up through the top left ring of the fivelet. Fold out the added rings.



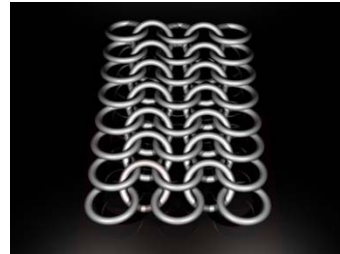
3. Keep adding rings as needed to your desired length.



4. Additionally you can add rings to the side to widen the weave



5. Again, keep adding rings in the same manner until you reach your desired length

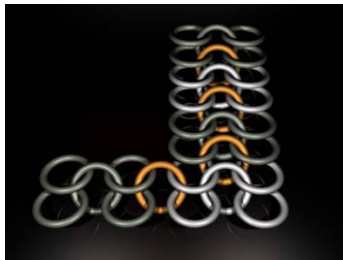

Speed Weaving Techniques

Start by creating a pile of fivelets



Then use a single ring to connect the fivelets to each other in a similar method as above. You can attach them in which ever direction you need to expand.



A method to turn this weave into a sheet quickly is to create multiple ribbons first.



Then stitch them together with extra rings.
